# PROGRAM 2026

### 1st DAY: Sat 21/03

- Meet at Calais around 07:00(\*) and check-in at DFDS Ferries.
- Breakfast possible on board in "Captain's self-service".
- Disembarkation in Dover around 10:30 local time.
- Via the "M20/24 Highway" we drive west towards "Brecon Beacons National Park" and over the mighty "Severn Crossing" bridge deep into central Wales.
- Lunch "free menu choice" en route. Arrival in LLANDOVERY around 18:00 (± 450 km).
- Aperitif and "Deliciously Farm Dinner" from 19:30
- A well-deserved night's rest, or enjoy the afterglow by the fireplace ....

# 22nd and 3rd DAY: Sun 22/03 and Mon 23/0

- Full Welsh Breakfast from 8.00 am.
- Around 9.00 am: we leave our home base and disappear together with our guide for the whole day with our "Welsh pick-nick" (or "local pub visit") in the "CAMBRIAN" MOUNTAINS" in search of "King Arthur" and his magical "Camelot".
